FROM THE TOP



In the past few months, the CRTA has been working on two initiatives to improve our understanding of the Canadian RegTech landscape.

First, leveraging work from other associations, we created a RegTech taxonomy to categorize and map Canadian RegTech firms, enabling participants to find appropriate solutions to meet their needs. The diagram at left is the initial result of our outreach to Canadian RegTech firms and includes approximately 40 firms. From our research, we believe there are about 70 RegTech firms in Canada. We will continue to update this infographic as we hear back from firms. If you are a Canadian RegTech firm and are not represented, please complete [this short survey](#) providing your consent.

Our second initiative is a benchmark survey to examine the extent of RegTech adoption in Canada. The objective of this survey is to understand the extent of RegTech adoption by Canadian Financial Institutions (FIs) and to provide business- and technology leaders with a benchmark to measure against their peers. This is our opportunity to evaluate the landscape, identify gaps and opportunities, and raise the bar both domestically and internationally. Global studies have examined the overall state of RegTech but Canada is often under-represented. The CRTA is working closely with other RegTech associations by sharing our knowledge and collaborating to create greater standardization and regulatory co-ordination, in an effort to put Canada on the world stage, and this information is an important step in that journey. Our survey should take approximately 15-20 minutes to complete. All answers will be aggregated and anonymously presented in a final report.
